

2009-2010 Rec End of Season Tournament

The U08, U10, and U12 Boys will be playing in a traditional 'seeding' tournament. The divisions have been divided and multi 1st and 2nd place medals will be awarded (one set per division). All of these games will be on Saturday, Feb 20th.

U06 Boys, U06 Girls, and U12 Girls are playing a Round Robin Style tournament where points are awarded based upon Wins, Loses, and Ties. The 1st and 2nd Place teams are determined by the total number of points earned. The U12 Girls 1st and 2nd Place teams will also play a final Championship game. These games will be played on Saturday Feb 20th and Sunday Feb 21st.

Rather than make up the tie breakers, we will use what FYSA does for the Region C tournament that our Flames teams are currently playing in. Therefore, standings in a group will be determined by:

GAME POINTS:

- 3 points for a Win
- 1 point for a Tie
- 1 point for a Shut Out WIN (None for a forfeit)
- 0 points for a Loss
- Forfeit recorded at 1-0 score

If two teams are tied on points based on the above at the end of group play, the advancers will be determined based on the following tie breakers:

TIE BREAKERS: U08, U10, U12 - Boys & Girls Only

- A. Head to head competition; if no clear winner then
- B. Net goal differential (max 3 per game); if no clear winner then
- C. Goals scored up to a maximum of three (3) goals per game, if no clear winner then
- D. Least goals allowed (max 3 per game);if no clear winner then
- E. Kicks from the penalty mark per FIFA rules

If there are more than 2 teams tied, option A will be skipped and the tiebreaker starts at option B above.

Shoot Out Rules

At the end of regulation, winners will be decided by PK, since there is no time to play an overtime period.

Only players on the field at the end of regulation may participate. Referees need to make sure and keep the players that were on the field at the final whistle **ON THE FIELD**. Need to make sure that the referees advise the coaches of this before the end of the game, to give them a chance to sub in who they'd like to participate.

The home team starts the PK shootout. The same goal is used for both teams. Goalies not defending stand behind the endline, off to the side far enough away so as to not be a distraction. All players on the field are at midfield, behind the centerline away from where the PKs are being taken.

Each team picks 5 players to take the first 5 kicks, any order. If it is still tied after 5 kicks for each team, it goes to sudden death. The first 5 PK participants cannot take shots in sudden death until all remaining players have taken a shot.

If it is still tied after all players have taken a shot, you start again from the top, same order until the tie is broken.

The penalty mark will be

- U12 - ten yards from the goal line
- U10 - eight yards from the goal line
- U08 - the edge of the goal box

The Goalie must be on the Goal Line when the shot is taken, and cannot advance towards the player taking the shot until the ball is touched and moves forward. The goalie can move side to side.

You can switch the goalie on every kick if you want to, and the goalie can be one of your players taking the penalty shot.
