The Wesley Chapel Athletic Association, Inc. (WCAA) is a non-profit organization formed for the specific purpose of responding to the recreational and sporting needs of the youth in the Wesley Chapel area. The WCAA was established to create a youth sports association, organize sports, and locate facilities for use as a result of the rapid growth in the Wesley Chapel area. Members of the WCAA also volunteer extensively throughout the Wesley Chapel and New Tampa area in churches, schools, and community events.

WCAA Sports

The WCAA offers seven different sports for boys and girls, ranging from under-4 to under-19 during the athletic year:

- Basketball (February - April)
 - Boys and girls
 - Under 8 through under-13
- Cheerleading (July - November)
 - Under-4 through under-13
- Flag Football (July - November)
 - Boys and girls
 - Under-7 through under-14
- Tackle Football (July – November)
 - Boys
 - Ages 5-15
- Lacrosse (Year round)
 - Boys and girls Under-6 through under-13
 - Middle/High school
 - Tribe (Select travel team)

Recreational Soccer (November - February)

The inaugural season started in 2000 with over 300 boys and girls participating in recreational soccer. Our Program now boasts more than 900 players ages 4 – 14.



Competitive Soccer (July – May)

Our goal is to provide opportunities to promote the sport through the proper tactical, physical, mental and emotional development of the kids while having fun playing soccer. The Flames program started three years ago with a U9 and a U12 Boys team. In 2009-10, we will field 20+ teams, and 300+ kids ages 7 - 18. Last season, the U11, U12, U15, and U19 boys all won their division titles. The U11 and U19 teams advanced to the Final 4 of the Region C Cup and the U19 team won the first championship and the D2 South Regional Cup.
